Beginners' Intensive Course

This course is purposely designed to set total beginners on the path to fluency as quickly and thoroughly as possible. A maximum of just 10 per class provides plenty of personal teacher focus.

Intensive Course

This, our most popular course, is designed to increase your fluency in as short a time as possible, and to introduce a range of specialist subjects taught in Special Interest Groups.

Diploma of English

This long-term course is the best value way to achieve real fluency, gain specialist subject knowledge and enjoy a memorable college year or semester abroad.

Compact Course

English Plus Business and Finance
